### School Uniform Policy

At Heronswood Primary School and Pre-School we expect all of our children to wear the correct school uniform. When parents/carers register their children at Heronswood they are agreeing to ensure their child is always correctly dressed and presented. Securing the right atmosphere in school is critical to our success.

School Uniform is an important aspect of school life as it plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school in many ways by;

- setting an appropriate tone
- instilling pride
- supporting positive behaviour and discipline
- encouraging identity with, and support for, school ethos
- ensuring pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome
- protecting children from social pressures to dress in a particular way
- nurturing cohesion

### Uniform in Pre-School

- Heronswood Pre-School School Navy Polo shirt with logo
- Turquoise jumper with school logo
- Suitable trousers, leggings, skirt & tights etc...

### Boys Uniform in School

- Heronswood Primary School Turquoise Polo shirt with logo
- Navy Blue School Jumper with school logo
- Grey Trousers
- Grey Shorts
- Grey/Black socks
- Black school shoes - Trainers, open toe shoes, and unsupported footwear are not allowed

### Girls Uniform in School

- Heronswood Primary School Turquoise Polo shirt with logo
- Navy Blue School Jumper with school logo
- Grey Trousers, Skirt or Pinafore Dress
- Navy or Green Gingham School Summer Dresses
- Mid-Grey or Black tights
- Grey or Black socks
- Black school shoes - Trainers, open toe shoes, boots, heels and unsupported footwear are not allowed

### PE Kit consists of

- Plain White polo shirt
- Navy Blue shorts
- Outdoor Trainers (Fashion footwear such as Vans or Toms are not suitable)
- Plain Navy Blue Tracksuit or Plain Navy Blue Sweatshirt and Jogging Bottoms for the winter months

### Additional Expectations

- **Jewellery** - On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school
- **Pierced Ears** - Where a child has pierced ears they are allowed to wear plain studs. For PE activities studs should be removed at home
- **Nail Varnish** and **make-up** must not be worn to school
- **Hair Styles** - Where a child has long hair it must be tied back using an appropriate hair bobble, clip or hair band. No extreme hair styles or cuts are allowed. Shaved heads, patterning / tramlines or engraved hair are not allowed. Extreme or unnatural colour is also not allowed. (The definition of extreme is at the discretion of the Head of School).
